MAJOR COURSEWORK

Completion and certification of CSU GE Breath will permit a student to transfer from Chabot College to a campus in the CSU system without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division general education courses. Students are required to complete a minimum of 39 units in areas A - F\* for full certification. CSU GE Breadth IS NOT applicable to any campus at the University m

# MAJOR:

### What else should I know about CSU GE?

- Each year the CSU GE pattern is updated, so select courses from the current year's agreement.
- Courses that appear in multiple areas may only be counted in one area, except the US History and American Institutions courses, which may also be used for Area D.

## How can I get more help with transfer?

- Make an appointment with a Chabot College Counselor to develop a Student Educational Plan (SEP) to clarify your goals and to map your course requirements.
- Join a Chabot College First Year Experience (FYE), Special Program, and/or take a Psychology-Counseling (PSCN) course to enhance college success
- Meet with transfer reps & attend workshops in the Transfer Center. Attend Chabot College Transfer Dav.
- Visit/tour transfer schools.

# What is CSU GE certification?

A process in which Chabot College verifes that your CSU GE is completed. After you have accepted an offer of admission to a CSU campus, you must submit a petition to the Chabot Admissions Offce requesting CSU GE certification. If CSU GE isn't completed prior to transfer, partial certification of CSU GE is also available. CSU certification is automatic for students who apply for, and earn, AA-T or AS-T degrees.

# GPA gives you more options.

## What classes do I need to complete for CSU transfer?

- Complete the "Golden Four" > CSU GE Areas A1, A2, A3 and B4.
- Early on, enroll in courses required for your major.
- Some major requirements may also satisfy general education requirements (ie. double-count).
- Whenever possible, choòse CSU GE classes of interest.

#### How do I fnd the courses required for my major?

Go to ASSIST (www.assist.org). If applicable, complete an Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) at Chabot College. For ADT degrees, see the Chabot College Catalog and/or DegreeWorks.
