



CSU GENERAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATION

1. What is the California State University (CSU) General Education Breadth (GE-Breadth)?

The CSU GE Breadth lists the coursework that allows students to fulfill 39 units of lower division general education at a California Community College prior to transferring to a CSU.

2. Is a minimum grade in all General Education courses required?

Students must have a "C" or better in (A1) Communication, (A2) English, (A3) Critical Thinking, and (B4) Mathematics and 30 units of general education courses with "C" or better grades. Courses with a grade of "D" in other areas are acceptable provided that the student has a cumulative 2.0 or higher GPA. Most CSU departments require a "C" or better in all courses, including GE, required in the major.

3. Are credit/no credit courses acceptable?
