

## Bay Advisor Categories for Advanced Searches

Advanced Search gives you the ability to search for categories of students through various criteria. Many students are already grouped by certain defining characteristics such as being a transfer student, a freshmen-cluster, a student-athlete, an Honors Student, etc. Within Advanced Search, you can search for these and many other student categories.

Below is a list of common student groupings with an explanation of what the Bay Advisor Category means. Utilizing categories in a search can be very helpful in determining more specific subsets of students. Categories will also appear in alphabetical order on the student overview page.

Category	
<b>Academic Internship</b>	Any student who has taken an internship coded class at East Bay.
<b>Academic Probation</b>	Students currently on Academic Probation.
<b>ADT – Similar Major</b>	Associate Degree for Transfer (STAR Act/SB1440)
<b>All FA Students</b>	Financial Aid receiving student.
<b>CA Promise</b>	Student is a transfer and under the California Promise contract.
<b>EGT</b>	Expected Graduation Term (will also include a term once student applies for graduation).

### Entry Term

	Access and retention program serving community college transfer students.
<b>Kaleidoscope Program</b>	Mentoring program for minority and underserved populations.
<b>Native GE Pattern</b>	Student began as a first-time freshman, non-transfer student.
<b>Renaissance Scholars</b>	Student support and success program serving foster youth.
<b>Sankofa Scholars Program</b>	Access and retention program serving community college transfer students.
<b>STEP Program</b>	Support program for second year students with a focus on retention and degree attainment.
<b>Transfer APASS</b>	Student support program for Asian American and Pacific Islander students at East Bay.
<b>Tau Sigma Honor Society</b>	National Honor Society for Transfer students that recognizes and promotes academic excellence and involvement of transfer students.
<b>Transfer Student</b>	Student first entered East Bay from either a community college or another four-year institution.
<b>Veteran Student</b>	Access and retention program serving veterans students who opt into the program.

<b>Western Undergraduate Exchange</b>	Student is not from California but is from one of the Western States and therefore qualifies for a certain tuition.
