CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this organization shall be the Associated Students, Inc.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE

The purpose of this organization shall be to promote the welfare of the student body and to act in the best interests of the University.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP

Any student of the University who is a member of one of the fraternities or sororities shall be eligible for membership in this organization.

ARTICLE IV

OFFICERS

The officers of this organization shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and a number of members not exceeding five.

The President shall be elected by the members of this organization for a term of one year.

The Vice President shall be elected by the members of this organization for a term of one year.

The Secretary shall be elected by the members of this organization for a term of one year.

The Treasurer shall be elected by the members of this organization for a term of one year.

The members shall be elected by the members of this organization for a term of one year.

ARTICLE V

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The financial statements of this organization shall be audited by a committee of members of this organization.

ARTICLE VI

AMENDMENTS

This constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members of this organization.
