The foster youth waiver shall be applied if any amount of systemwide tuition fees remains, after the other sources of state or federal financial aid including the Chafee grant, Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG), Cal Grant, Pell and scholarships have been included in determining eligibility.
